The main purpose of this level of care is that it provides for many individuals (who are primarily elderly) and their families a delivery system that allows for a home-like atmosphere, while maintaining continuous supervision of health care and daily activity needs.

Licensed Residential Health Care Facilities provide the following services: (1) 24-hour supervision; (2) Provision of Assistance with personal hygiene, management of funds for clothing and other purchases and supervision of all medication; (3) Health Maintenance and Monitoring Services include assessment of medical, social, and health history needs and corresponding plans to meet those needs. (Registered Nurse); (4) dietary services; (5) arrangement for activity participation in and outside the facility.
