request in writing that the same be disclosed publicly.

9. Matters Relating to the Potential Imposition of a Penalty. Any deliberations of a public body

occurring after a public hearing that may result in the imposition of a specific civil penalty upon the

responding party or the suspension or loss of a license or permit belonging to the responding party bears

responsibility.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Bergen County Board of Social Services,

assembled in public session on June 2, 2020 that an Executive Session closed to the public shall be held on

July 9, 2020 at 4:30 P.M. at the Bergen County Board of Social Services, 218 Route 17 North, Rochelle

Park, New Jersey, for the discussion of matters relating to the specific items designated above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is anticipated that the deliberations conducted in closed

session will be disclosed to the public upon the determination of the Bergen County Board of Social

Services that the public interest will no longer be served by such confidentiality as set forth above.
