Administration Report:

(a) Monthly Reports – Statistical & Financial:

A snapshot of caseload and expenditures was included in each of the Board Member's packets.

Scott Modery reported that the TANF (Temporary Assistance to Needy Families) caseload for July 2023 was 353 and June 2023 was 369 cases, and compared to one year ago it went up 72 cases, SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program) caseload for July was 22,958 and June was 22,693 and compared to one year ago it went up by 1,119 cases, GA (General Assistance) caseload for July was 407 and June was 402 cases and compared to one year ago it went down by 4 cases. In regard to Medicaid, there were 57,939 individuals in July and in June 2023 there were 60,293 individuals a decrease of 2,354 individuals.

Burial stats are as follows: 17 inquires, 29 approved, and 3 denials. The agency paid out \$72,408.00 and recovered \$765.90.

In July 2023, the agency received 1,691 applications for cash and SNAP applications and 1,615 Medicaid applications for a total of 3,306. In June 2023, the agency received 1,540 applications for cash and SNAP applications and 1,295 Medicaid applications for a total of 2,835.

Our Emergency Assistance Unit assisted homeless individuals and families. Currently, we have 4 individuals/families in motels. We have 26 families in the HEARTS Program, 14 in the Emergency Shelter, and 12 in TANF/Bridge side. We have 8 families placed at the Center for Hope and Safety (DV shelter). We had 66 Emergency Assistance applications and 94 clients on Temporary Rental Assistance. We had 35 placements as referrals from 211. We have 247 active DDD cases. The Adult Protective Service (APS) Unit received 124 referrals and currently have 36 open cases.

(b) Memoranda to the Board

During August AON released their analysis and recommendations for the 2024 State Health Benefits premium year. AON is commissioned by the State each year and their analysis has been regarded as a benchmark for rate increases over the years. This year, AON has recommended a 7.4% increase in health benefit rates for active employees. Medicare retirees are recommended to increase by 8.8%. My early forecast based upon these recommendations would mean an increase in our 2024 budget of approximately \$500,000 for health benefits alone. New Jersey has conducted its annual point in time survey of the homeless population. A very limited cross section of this

information was included as an attachment to Mr. Modery's memorandum and shared with the Board. An additional attachment contained a link to the full report and statistics for anyone interested. September will be the final month for ARPA funding to fund our SNAP overtime. As applications remain elevated and return to pre-pandemic processes increase workload, we can expect overtime costs to remain elevated. Our extensive attempts to have the fictitious Bergen County Board of Social Services Facebook page taken down have all failed. We have contacted the Prosecutors Office, forwarded multiple letters from our in-house attorney and received no response; contacted the local San Mateo County Social Services Department for advice, attempted to use a family member of an employee who works for Facebook, and filed internal red flags on Facebook itself. At the present time, we have exhausted all options. In regard to Facebook, at the Board's request, Scott Modery will forward all the documentation to John L. Schettino, Esq. so he can look into this issue further. Lastly, on site work for our 2022 audit has been completed. While there are still items to coordinate before a report can be issued, by all appearances the audit report will be on par with prior years.
