Administration Report:

(a) Monthly Reports - Statistical & Financial:

A snapshot of caseload and expenditures was included in each of the Board Member's packets.

Scott Modery reported that the TANF (Temporary Assistance to Needy Families) caseload for December 2023 was 337 and November 2023 was 351 cases, and compared to one year ago it went down 34 cases. SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program) caseload for December 2023 was 23,236 and November 2023 was 23,378 and compared to one year ago it went up by 1,402 cases. GA (General Assistance) caseload for December 2023 was 481 and November 2023 was 491 cases and compared to one year ago it went up by 77 cases. In regard to Medicaid, there were 49,796 individuals in December 2023 and in November 2023 there were 50,423 individuals a decrease of 627 individuals.

Burial stats are as follows: 27 inquires, 29 approved, and 0 denials. The agency paid out \$52,542.00 and recovered \$626.84.

In December 2023, the agency received 1,492 applications for cash and SNAP applications and 2,135 Medicaid applications for a total of 3,627. In November 2023, the agency received 1,580 applications for cash and SNAP applications and 2,146 Medicaid applications for a total of 3,726.

Our Emergency Assistance Unit assisted homeless individuals and families. Currently, we have 1 individual/family in motels. We have 24 families in the HEARTS Program, 12 in the

Emergency Shelter, and 12 in TANF/Bridge side. We have 10 families placed at the Center for Hope and Safety (DV shelter). We had 48 Emergency Assistance applications and 88 clients on Temporary Rental Assistance. We had 40 placements as referrals from 211. We have 242 active DDD cases. The Adult Protective Service (APS) Unit received 93 referrals and currently have 34 open cases.

(b) Memoranda to the Board

Scott Modery reported that Ryan Barone, Supervisor of the Claims and Fraud Departments, will be making a presentation this evening on the processes of these departments. Mr. Barone has been a BCBSS employee for over 24 years and has supervised the Claims and Fraud Departments since 2019. The agency had a Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) E&T (Employment and Training) review conducted by FNS on 1/31/2024. This placed additional pressure on our staff because it occurred in tandem with an ongoing M&E (Monitoring and Evaluation) review. However, we were told that Bergen County was specifically selected by the Division of Family Development (DFD) to be the one county FNS reviewed because of our solid reputation for process and procedure. Our cooperation in this review helps DFD maintain their reputation and thus promotes a positive relationship. In 2023 we promoted 27 employees. Additionally, we have reduced the number of part-time staff which stood at 33 in December 2022 and is 19 today. It is important to remember that of the remaining 19 employees, not all are interested in full-time employment. Dolores Phillips, Eglantina Mataj and Janice Reid attended the "Project Homeless Connect" event on Wednesday 1/24/2024. BCBSS purchased 196 pairs of socks to distribute at the event. Additionally, CWA 1089 raised \$670 through a jean's day event. The agency raised an additional \$600 by raffling a Personal Day. In all, our employees donated a total of \$1,270. On 1/26/2024 Maya Jacob attended the Greater Bergen Community Action's Head Start Community Resource Awareness Event for enrolled families with children up to age 5. Ms. Jacob hosted a table and did a short presentation for what BCBSS has to offer. We provided rub on tattoos and lollipops for distribution to the children.
