States.		
3. Matters Involving Individual Privacy. Any material the disclosure of which constitutes an		
unwarranted invasion of individual privacy such as any records, data, reports, recommendations, or other		
personal material of any educational, training, social service, medical, health, custodial, child protection,		
rehabilitation, legal defense, welfare, housing, relocation, insurance and similar program or institution		
operated by a public body pertaining to any specific individual admitted to or served by such institution or		
program, including but not limited to information relative to the individual's personal and family		
circumstances, and any material pertaining to admission, discharge, treatment, progress or condition of any		
individual, unless the individual concerned (or, in the case of a minor or incompetent, his guardian) shall		
request in writing that the same be disclosed publicly.		
_X4. Matters Relating to Collective Bargaining Agreements. Any collective bargaining agreement,		
or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement,		
including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of		
employees of the public body, with respect to: (a) discussion regarding aligning salary increase for		
confidential employees with union staff.		
X5. Matters Relating to the Purchase, Lease or Acquisition of Real Property or the Investment of		
Public Funds. Any matter involving the purchase, lease or acquisition of real property with public funds,		
the setting of banking rates or investment of public funds, where it could adversely affect the public		
interest if discussion of such matters were disclosed specifically with respect to 218 Route 17 North,		
Rochelle Park, New Jersey, specifically with respect to (a) discussion regarding Building Issues. The		
minutes will be released on or before, 20 when the issues pertaining to the		
Lease and First Amendment to the Lease have been approved and finalized.		
6. Matters Relating to Public Safety and Property. Any tactics and techniques utilized in protecting		
the safety and property of the public, provided that their disclosure could impair such protection. Any
